Area Preparation

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS: Wear chemical resistant gloves, safety goggles, and protective clothing. Do not mix with any other chemicals or other household cleaning products as hazardous fumes may result. Surfaces are slippery when wet; use caution when walking on wet surfaces.

Spray all plants and vegetation liberally with water before and after application. Cover delicate vegetation to avoid damage. Prevent contact with metal, fabric, floor coverings, or lawn furniture.

Application

Test a hidden area, rinse and let dry before using this product. This product is Ready-To-Use. **DO NOT THIN.** Shake well before using. Sweep clean then wet surface with water before applying product. For vertical surfaces, work from bottom to top. Apply product evenly with brush, roller or garden sprayer. Product may damage metal components of spray equipment. Allow product to stand for 20–30 minutes then scrub surface with nylon brush. Make sure to keep surface wet and do not use a wire brush. Rinse surface and adjacent areas using highest pressure from hose. Allow surface to dry 24–48 hours before staining or painting. **FOR PERIODIC CLEANING OF COMPOSITE DECKING:** Apply only when air, surface, and product temperatures are between 10°C (50°F) and 32°C (90°F). Apply the cleaner liberally and work into the surface with a stiff broom (slight foaming should be seen, if not apply more cleaner). Thoroughly rinse, let dry, and apply a second application if needed. **RECOMMENDED SPRAY EQUIPMENT:** Apply cleaner at full strength with a plastic, pump-style garden sprayer and hose.
