All surfaces must be clean, dry and free of dust, dirt, chalking and peeling paint, wax, grease or any other contamination. Repair any surface defects before painting.

New Surfaces:

**Drywall -** Apply a prime coat of Monarch 6217 Paramount Latex Primer-Sealer.

Plaster or Masonry - All surfaces must cure for at least 30 days before painting. Prime with Monarch 4690 M-Prime Interior/Exterior Primer or Monarch 6060 Latex Undercoat.

Bare Wood - Prime with Monarch 4690 M-Prime, or for faster dry, Monarch 7704 Lacquer Undercoat or Monarch 6060 Latex Enamel Undercoat. Lightly sand and dust clean.

Ferrous Metals - Prime with Monarch 5512 Red Iron Oxide or 5513 Universal Primer.

Non-ferrous or Galvanized Metals - Prime with Monarch 5510 Galvanized Tron Primer.

#### Previously Painted Surfaces:

Dull glossy surfaces by sanding and dust clean. Remove all loose and peeling paint, spot prime bare area with Monarch 6217 Paramount Latex Primer-Sealer or appropriate Monarch primer.

Not for use on floors.

## MIXING AND THINNING

**Tinting -** May be tinted with Monarch's universal colorants from pastel to ultra deep shades.

**Thirming -** Thirming is not normally needed. If necessary, use only a small amount of Monarch 7710 All Purpose Thirmer (up to 1/2 pint per gallon). Do not use lacquer thirmer.

### **APPLICATION**

**Method -** Apply with a flexible bristle brush, 3/8" rap roller, or spray. For airless spray, use .013" or larger tip, adjust pressure as necessary.

Dry Time - Under normal conditions to touch in 4 to 6 hours and to recoat overnight. Provide adequate ventilation. Adverse conditions may affect drying time.

**Cleanup** - Clean equipment promptly with Monarch 7710 All Purpose Thinner. Wet a cloth with Monarch 7710 All Purpose Thinner or mineral spirits to wipe up spatters and drips.

**Washing** - May be wiped clean with sponge and mild liquid detergent. Do not use abrasive cleaners or rough cloth for washing. Allow at least 21 days for proper curing.
