PRODUCT TYPE: Water/Sodium Hypochlorite

DENSITY: 1.1 Kg/L

FLASH POINT: Over 93°C (200°F)

SPREADING RATE PER COAT: Approximately 23 to 28 m² (250 to 300 ft²) per 3.78 L.

CLEANUP: Rinse spray equipment thoroughly with water.

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry location. Avoid exposure to sunlight. Do not reuse container. Rinse container thoroughly before disposal.

DISPOSAL: Consult your municipality in order to dispose of paint residues according to environmental regulations. Do not pour down a drain or storm sewer.

GENERAL SURFACE PREPARATION

Proper surface preparation is essential for the Olympic limited warranty to apply. Surfaces to be cleaned must be thoroughly dry.

PRETEST: Always test a small hidden area, rinse and let dry before using this product.

AREA PREPARATION: Spray all plants and vegetation liberally with water before and after application.

Cover delicate vegetation to avoid damage.

Do not allow to come into contact with metal, fabric, floor coverings, or lawn furniture.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

FOR EXTERIOR USE ONLY.

Always test a small hidden area, rinse and let dry before using this product.

Spray the affected area liberally and allow to stand for 5-10 minutes.

When treating vertical surfaces, apply from bottom to top.

Cleaning action will occur within minutes.

Thoroughly rinse treated surface and surrounding areas with large amounts of water to neutralize cleansing action. A second application may be applied if necessary.

Application Equipment: Use a plastic, pump-style garden sprayer and hose.

FOR PERIODIC CLEANING OF COMPOSITE DECKING: Apply Deck Cleaner liberally and work into surface with a stiff broom (slight foaming should be seen, if not apply more cleaner).

Rinse, let dry, apply a second application if needed.

Slight yellowing of the deck is normal and will fade in a matter of days.
