	Wash off all residues with clean water and dry thoroughly with a clean cloth. The area should now have a uniform matt appearance. NOTE: Failure to remove all residues could impair adhesion of subsequent coats of paint.	
	Wipe panel thoroughly using the appropriate Nexa Autocolor precleaner before applying paint.	
***	Apply Nexa Autocolor topcoat Refer to Aerosol Fade-out Process PDS.
