### GENERAL DESCRIPTION

*Quick Cover by Olympic* Stain is recommended for use on properly prepared exterior or interior wood, including decks, fences, siding, railings, outdoor furniture and other wood surfaces. Apply to new, dry, pressure-treated wood, uncoated new or weathered wood, or previously coated wood with a weathered clear sealant or semi-transparent stain.

**COVERAGE:** Approximately 250 to 350 sq. ft. (23 to 33 sq. meters) per U.S. gallon (3.78 L) depending on application, wood texture, and porosity. Coverage figures do not include loss due to surface irregularities and porosity or material loss due to application method or mixing.

**DRYING TIME:** Dry time @ 77°F (25°C); 50% relative humidity.  
To Touch: 1 hour  
To Recoat: 2 hours

Application in high humidity or in temperatures below 50°F (10°C) may prolong drying times. Allow 24 to 48 hours of drying time before light foot traffic or replacing furniture.

**CLEANUP:** Clean brushes and tools with warm, soapy water.

**DISPOSAL:** Contact your local environmental regulatory agency for guidance on disposal of unused product. Do not pour down a drain or storm sewer.

**FLASH POINT:** Over 200°F (93°C)

### LIMITATIONS OF USE

Apply when no precipitation is expected for 24 hours, and when air and surface temperatures are 50°F (10°C) to 90°F (32°C) and will remain above 50°F (10°C) for the next two hours. Avoid staining in direct sunlight or on hot surfaces.

PROTECT FROM FREEZING.

## GENERAL SURFACE PREPARATION

Surface must be clean. Remove all dust, dirt, mildew, oil, loose wood fibers, and other contaminants. Remove loose, peeling stain by sanding, scraping, or wire brushing. To ensure proper penetration, weathered, dirty, or mildewed surfaces should be cleaned with a wood cleaner prior to applying stain. After rinsing, ensure surface is free of standing water. Remove grade stamps or pencil marks by sanding.

**WARNING!** If you scrape, sand, or remove old paint, you may release lead dust or fumes. LEAD IS TOXIC. EXPOSURE TO LEAD DUST OR FUMES CAN CAUSE SERIOUS ILLNESS, SUCH AS BRAIN DAMAGE, ESPECIALLY IN CHILDREN. PREGNANT WOMEN SHOULD ALSO AVOID EXPOSURE. Wear a properly fitted, NIOSH-approved respirator and prevent skin contact to control lead exposure. Clean up carefully with a HEPA vacuum and a wet mop. Follow these instructions to control exposure to other hazardous substances that may be released during surface preparation.

**WOOD:** Countersink all nails, putty flush with surface. Unpainted wood or wood in poor condition should be sanded smooth and wiped clean, then stained.

**EXTRACTIVE BLEEDING:** Some woods, such as redwood and cedar contain natural water-soluble colorings or extractives that tend to “bleed” or migrate to the surface. If extractive bleeding occurs, allow the coating to dry completely, then wash with a mild detergent solution and rinse with clear water.

## APPLICATION INFORMATION

Stir thoroughly and often during use. When using more than one can of the same color, intermix to ensure color uniformity. USE WITH ADEQUATE VENTILATION. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Read all label and Safety Data Sheet (SDS) information prior to use. SDS are available through our web site or by calling 1-800-441-9695.

**Application Equipment:** Apply to a small area and allow stain to dry to ensure acceptable appearance and penetration. Apply one coat with a high-quality brush, paint/stain pad, or with spray equipment for a semi-transparent hiding effect. When applying by roller or spray, always back-brush for best results. To help avoid lap marks, apply to only a few boards at a time, and maintain a wet edge. Apply a second coat between 2 to 72 hours after first coat for a solid color hiding effect. After staining of picnic tables, benches, or indoor and outdoor furniture, topcoat with a high-quality gloss varnish to prevent staining of clothing.

**Airless Spray:** Pressure 1500-2000 psi, tip 0.009" - 0.013". Spray equipment must be handled with due care and in accordance with manufacturer's recommendation. High-pressure injection of coatings into the skin by airless equipment may cause serious injury.

**Brush:** Nylon/Polyester Brush

**Roller:** 3/8" - 3/4" nap roller cover

**Thinning:** Do not thin.
