GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Ceiling Paint is a spatter-resistant low-VOC vinyl-acrylic latex designed to meet the maintenance needs of residential repainters, remodelers, commercial contractors, facility and property managers. The great hide and coverage of this white ceiling paint helps mask minor surface imperfections and dries quickly to a smooth and clean finish. For interior use on new and previously painted wood, drywall and plaster.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Mix thoroughly before use. Apply at package consistency. Apply with a quality 1/4" - 3/8" nap roller or nylon polyester brush. An extension pole is recommended for making longer strokes; making it easier to maintain a wet-edge. To reduce lap marks and ensure that you do not miss any areas, try to keep the light source at your back and start by painting away from the window. If there is more than one window, choose the largest window. **USE WITH ADEQUATE VENTILATION. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.** Read all label and Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) information prior to use. MSDS are available through our website or by calling 1-800-454-3336.

Application Equipment: Apply with a high quality roller or brush.

Brush: Polyester/Nylon Brush

Roller: 1/4" - 3/8" nap roller cover

Thinning: Thinning is not required

DRYING TIME: Dry time @ 77°F (25°C); 50% relative humidity
To Touch: 30 - 60 minutes
To Recoat: 2 - 4 hours

Drying times listed may vary depending on temperature, humidity, film build, color, and air movement.

CLEANUP: Clean hands and tools immediately with warm, soapy water. Clean spills right away with a damp cloth.

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS: After 30 days or when paint has fully cured, areas may be washed using a non-abrasive, mild detergent solution and cellulose sponge.

DISPOSAL: Contact your local environmental regulatory agency for guidance on disposal of unused product. Do not pour down a drain or storm sewer.

GENERAL SURFACE PREPARATION

Surfaces to be coated must be dry, clean, sound, and free from all contamination including loose and peeling paint, dirt, grease, oil, wax, concrete curing agents and bond breakers, chalk, efflorescence, mildew, rust, product fines, and dust. Remove loose paint, chalk, and efflorescence by wire brushing, scraping, sanding, and/or pressure washing. Putty all nail holes and caulk all cracks and open seams. Sand all glossy, rough, and patched surfaces. Feather back all rough edges to sound surface by sanding.

WARNING! If you scrape, sand, or remove old paint, you may release lead dust or fumes. **LEAD IS TOXIC. EXPOSURE TO LEAD DUST OR FUMES CAN CAUSE SERIOUS ILLNESS, SUCH AS BRAIN DAMAGE, ESPECIALLY IN CHILDREN. PREGNANT WOMEN SHOULD ALSO AVOID EXPOSURE.** Wear a properly fitted NIOSH-approved respirator and prevent skin contact to control lead exposure. Clean up carefully with a HEPA vacuum and a wet mop. In Canada contact a regional Health Canada office. Follow these instructions to control exposure to other hazardous substances that may be released during surface preparation.

NEW SURFACES:

Drywall: Joint compound must dry for two days before priming. Prime with the appropriate latex drywall primer.

Wood: Set nails, fill with latex spackle. Sand smooth. Dust clean. Prime with appropriate latex wood primer.

Concrete, Plaster and Masonry: Cure at least 30 days before painting. pH must be 10.0 or lower. Roughen slick poured or precast concrete and remove sealers by chemical cleaning or abrasive method such as sandsweeping. Rinse thoroughly with water and allow to dry. Must be internally dry. Remove loose aggregate. Prime with the appropriate latex bonding primer for concrete. Fill concrete block with a latex block filler. Prime plaster with the appropriate latex primer for plaster.

PREVIOUSLY PAINTED SURFACES: Wash to remove contaminants. Rinse thoroughly with water and allow to dry. Dull glossy areas by light sanding. Remove sanding dust. Remove loose paint. Prime bare areas with primer specified under **NEW SURFACES**.

LIMITATIONS OF USE

Apply when air and surface temperatures are between 50°F (10°C) and 90°F (32°C). Do not apply when the surface or air temperature is below 50°F (10°C).
